

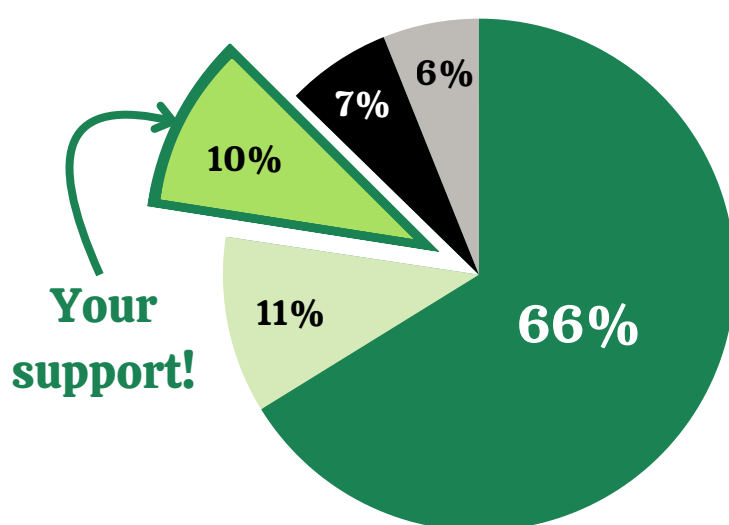
The West End Expansion Project

The West End Expansion Project will complete 11 Master Plan initiatives and create additional programming opportunities through the year-round use of the Log Cabin, a Pioneer Landscape, a storytelling space, and reclaimed lawn space. As one of 20 recipients of a Michigan Community Museum Grant, \$399,770 of the project costs will be reimbursed, but we need your help! **We need \$60,000 in individual donations to make this project a success and set the groundwork for the next steps in our Master Plan!**

Project Goals:

- Move the Log Cabin and add heat for year-round programming
- Move and update the Pioneer Garden and Herb Garden
- Move and improve the Pioneer Landscape including outbuildings
- Extend the Village fence line
- Remove a utility pole to reclaim lawn space
- Add a storytelling space for Indigenous programming
- Add a rain garden and other natural drainage to reclaim lawn space
- Add staff parking to increase capacity for large programs
- Add trees and landscaping for natural screening
