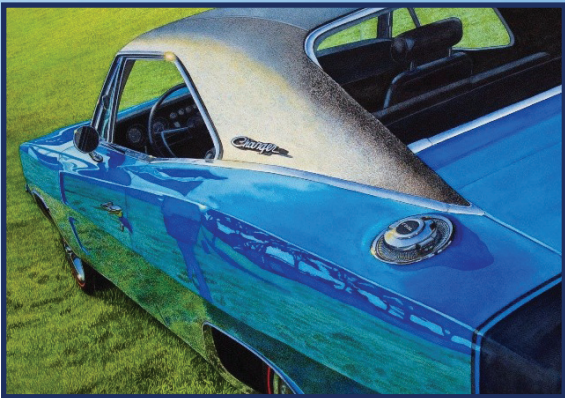

The Ford and Multimatic's Le Mans program with Moray Callum and Garen Nicoghosian

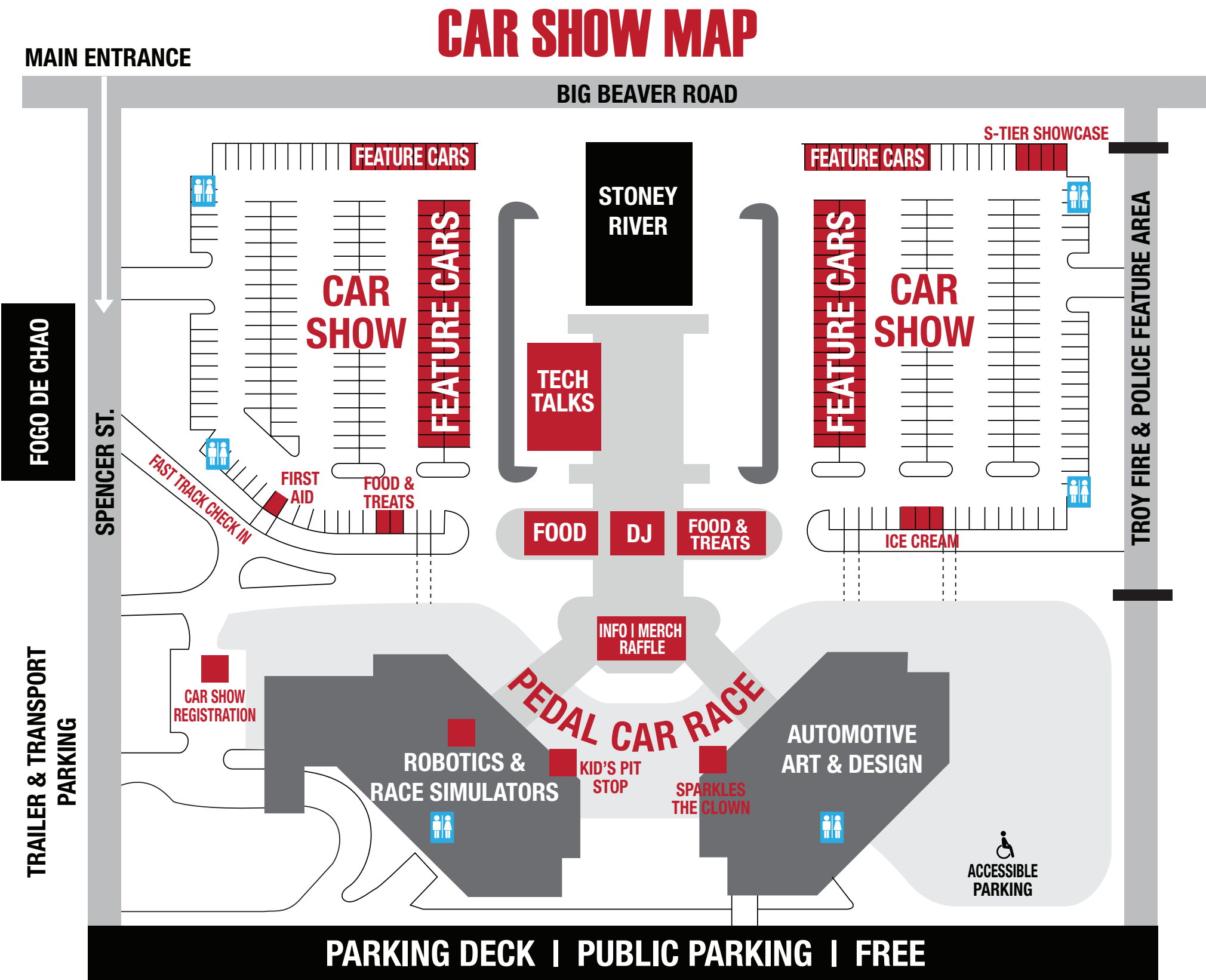

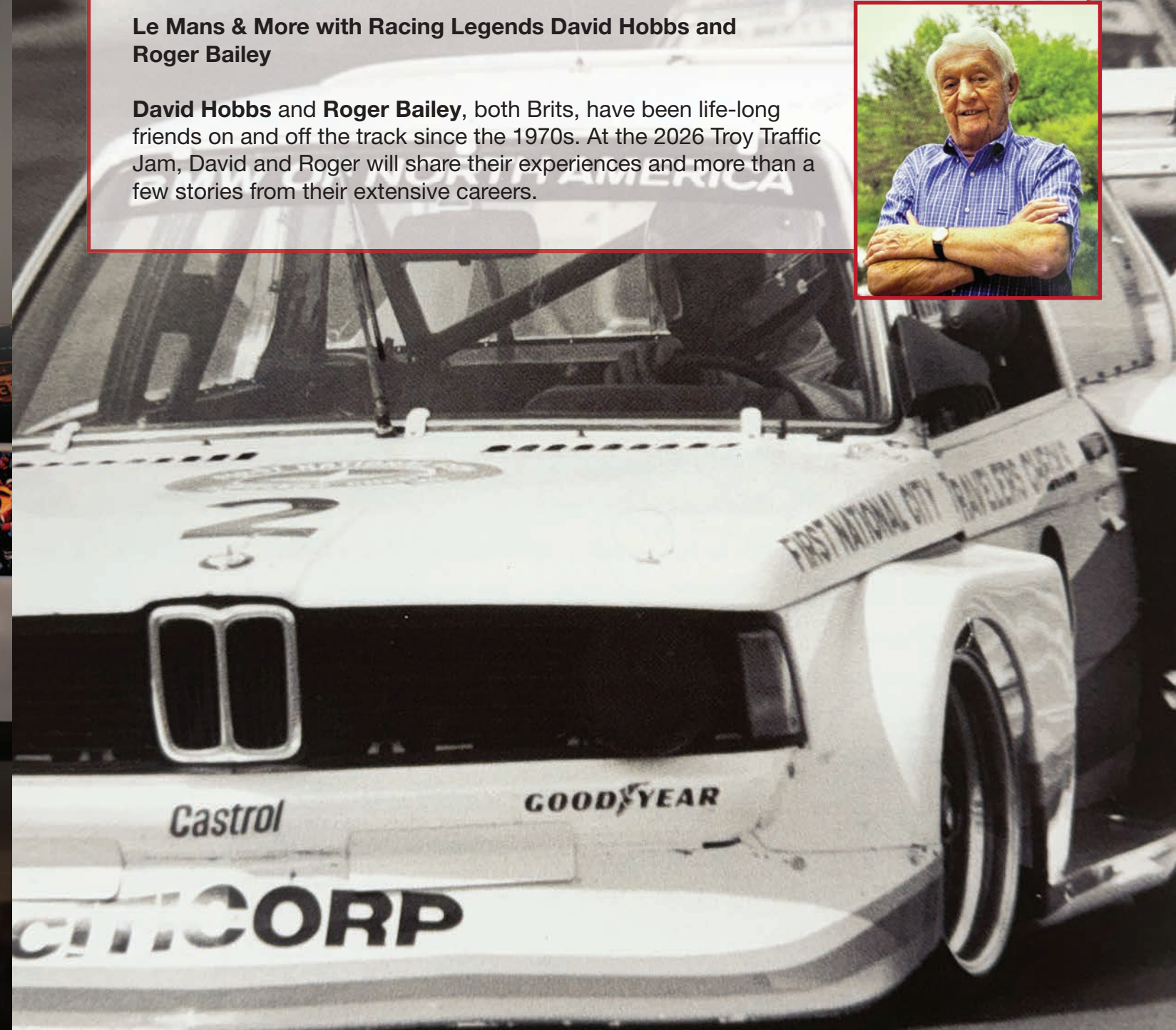
