Over 1,200 8th grade students are expected to join us during Civil War Days at the Village for the next two weeks! Volunteers help by guiding students through the program stops and making sure their company groups stick to the prepared schedule. Students (and their volunteer guides!) will get to hear wonderful stories from a Civil War surgeon, President Lincoln, soldier recruitment, and so much more.

The shifts are 8:30am - 1:45pm-ish. If you sign up for more than one day, you're welcome to bring a book or some other activity to work on while the students are in presentations. The most important part of guides is dropping off and picking up the students! Volunteering for Civil War Days is a great way to experience a program that is only for students!
