Abstract:

The Wattles Family Manuscript Collection consists primarily of records, donated by Morris Wattles, who was active in preserving the community's history.

Alexander Wattles (b. 1783 d. 1869) settled in Troy Township in 1837. He and his wife, Marcia Bennett Wattles. Silas Bennett Wattles (b. 1827 d. 1912) married Helen M. Harris In 1855, and had one child Harry Bennett Wattles (b. 1856 d. 1939). Harry and Sarah Jane (Jennie) Bingham married in 1876, and had a daughter, Helen Mary. After Jennie died in 1890, Harry married family friend Mattie E. Axtell in 1892. Three years later she gave birth to a son, Morris Axtell Wattles. Morris and his half-sister Helen Mary, neither of whom married, resided in the Wattles family home until their deaths.

The Wattles house, built c. 1845 by Clark Beardsley, was purchased by the Wattles family c. 1876 and modified in 1909, still stands at 3864 Livernois Road.
