Biographical Information:

Dorothy J. Scott was born on September 1, 1923. Dorothy was a strong advocate for historic preservation in Troy. She served on the Historic District Commission during the 1970s and 1980s where she and a small committee worked to obtain local historic designations on older homes and buildings like the Troy Methodist Church. A woman of strong principles, she was often at odds with City leadership and developers intent on new construction rather than preservation.

The papers and photographs of the Dorothy Scott Collection reflect her work as an advocate for historic preservation and her involvement in the community of Troy. Mrs. Scott passed away in 2009.

Series I: Photographs, Box 1-11

Contains photographs, negatives, slides, and microfiche. Topics include: historic Troy buildings, Wattles family portraits, Troy cemeteries, Troy Fire Department, and various newspaper microfiche. [note: boxes 5, 6, and 20 were removed to the Wattles Family Collection

Series II: Newspaper Clippings, Box 12-14

Contains various newspaper clippings relating to the City of Troy and efforts of its preservation. Includes the preservation of historic homes and building outside the Troy area as well.

Series III: Copies of Troy City Records, Box 15-18

Contains various copies of early Troy records dating back from the 1800s. Records include city surveys, title abstracts, subdivision proposals, assessment rolls, historical site preservation plans, Troy City Council, and Troy Historic District materials.

Series IV: History of Troy & Preservation Documents, Box 19-20

Contains documents relating to the history and founding of the City of Troy, as well as documents pertaining to preservation efforts set forth by the Troy Heritage Foundation. Includes materials on the preservation of Troy cemeteries, Troy churches, documents relating to the Wattles family and preservation of their historic home.

Series V: Correspondences & Notes, Box 21 Various correspondences to and from Dorothy Scott, mostly relating to Troy preservation issues. Also includes handwritten notes from Dorothy on various topics, full notebooks and a 1972 day planner.

Series VI: War Related Materials & Miscellaneous Documents, Box 22 Contains various miscellaneous documents related to the city of Troy. Other materials include documents related to the Civil War and Michigan,

copies of Civil War soldier lists, miscellaneous documents and copies of documents from the pre to post WWII era with some relating to Troy, birth, death, marriage records, and copies of journal pages.
