Capture beautiful fall leaves and their many colors in watercolor! We’ll take a look around the Village first to find some falling leaves for inspiration (optional). Inspiration photos will also be provided. You’ll make several small paintings of leaf studies.



**September 28:
Barns & Brushstrokes**

Paint a barn-themed landscape with watercolor.

**October 26:
Gorgeous Gourds**

Explore the world of gourds! You’ll paint several small images of various brightly colored gourds.

Pleasant Pheasant**

Michigan’s ring-necked pheasant brims with beautiful autumn colors. This class features the pretty bird and its many splendid shades.

Scarecrow Splash**
